TOWRADGI PUBLIC SCHOOL 2023 SWIMMING CARNIVAL

- WHEN: Tuesday 14th February, 2023
- WHERE: Corrimal Swimming Pool
- WHO: Competitors: Years 3-6 and year 2 students who are turning 8 this year who can swim 50m competently.

Spectators: This year, we are inviting students who are in Years 3 - 6 who don't wish to compete in the carnival to attend it as spectators and cheer their Sports House competitors on.

All attending spectators (parents and students) <u>cannot</u> enter any of the swimming pools at the Corrimal Swimming Centre during the carnival.

TIME: 12pm – 3pm

- COST: Competitors: \$6.50 (which includes entry to the pool and the hire of equipment from Corrimal Swimming Club). Spectators: \$0.60
- **TRANSPORT:** Both competitors and spectating students will be transported to and from the carnival by buses supplied by Corrinal High School.

PARENT/FAMILY

SPECTATORS: Parent and family members are most welcome to attend, however a fee of \$0.60 will have to be paid for each family spectator entering the pool. In addition, we ask that parents assist us in supervising their children to ensure that the carnival is run in a respectful and appropriate manner.

SPECIAL NOTE FOR COMPETITORS:

- The children who enter these events *must be able to swim these distances and styles.*
- Remember: hat, shirt, sunscreen, food, water and school uniform.
- Children will be allowed to make purchases at the pool canteen if it is open.
- We are <u>NOT</u> allowed to use the toddler or 25 metre pool as these are reserved for the public.
- At the conclusion of the carnival, children will be transported back to school by bus.
- If you wish your child/children to leave with you at the conclusion of the carnival, you will need to sign your child/children out with your child's/children's class teacher(s).

Please note that the age group for any competitor is the age that they turn this year.
